Subject: NOTICE OF MANDATORY WATER USE RESTRICTIONS

Due to the need to conserve both ground and surface water supplies, certain water use restrictions are now necessary and must be implemented at this time. Therefore, under the 2011 Drought Contingency Plan on file with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, Stage II, - Moderate Water Shortage Conditions now exist and mandatory water use restrictions will begin upon receipt of this notice, and will remain in effect until our water supply conditions improve.

A **Stage II condition** restricts your water use as follows:

1. Irrigation of Landscaped areas. Irrigation with hose-end sprinklers or in-ground irrigation systems shall be limited to **ONCE** weekly in accordance with the attached weekly watering schedule. (See watering schedule on following page.)
2. Vehicle Washing. Only on designated days and times (See watering schedule on following page.) and only with a hand held bucket or a hand held hose equipped with a positive shut off nozzle.
3. Pools. Filling of swimming pools, hot tubs, wading pools and other types of pools is prohibited. Replenishing pools to the maintenance level is permitted.
4. A complete listing of watering restrictions may be obtained at our office during normal working hours.

The Board of Directors has authorized surcharges contained in the Dripping Springs Water Supply Corporation 2011 Drought Contingency Plan that may be levied on a member/customer's account if a violation is found with applicable water use restrictions. Subsequent violations may result in temporary termination of water service. If you feel you have good cause for an exemption from the water use restriction regulations, please contact our office and request a copy of Section 11.2 -- Variances from the 2011 Drought Contingency Plan for information relating to filing a written request for variance. A complete copy of our approved 2011 Drought Contingency Plan is available for review at our office during normal business hours. A copy may be obtained upon request and payment of our standard copying charges.

Thank you for your assistance with conserving our water resources.

I. Once per Week Watering Schedule

Irrigate outdoors using an in-ground irrigation system or hose-end sprinkler no more than Once per week only during scheduled days and times as indicated below;

A. Residential

- Odd number addresses: Wednesday
- Even number addresses: Thursday

B. Commercial (Includes landscapes, such as HOA common areas)

- Tuesday

C. Watering Hours

- Midnight to 10 a.m., and
- 7: p.m. to midnight
