The Dripping Springs Water Supply Corporation ("DSWSC") Board of Directors accepted the resignation of Board President Jon Cobb at last night's regular meeting. Mr. Cobb, who has served on the board since April 2010, sold his property in Dripping Springs and will no longer be part of the member-owned utility.

During his tenure, Mr. Cobb brought a new and often brilliant perspective to dealing with Central Texas water issues. Under Mr. Cobb's leadership the member-owned utility:

- Executed a long-term agreement to provide water service to the Caliterra subdivision and its 550 single-family residential units. This process was many years in the making, and as President, Mr. Cobb found a creative solution that was mutually beneficial to both parties. This agreement was to the benefit of existing customers and future customers alike.
- Organized the first joint board meeting between the DSWSC and the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District ("HTGCD"). The joint meeting yielded a resolution to long-outstanding litigation between the two entities; resolved the amount of fees due to the HTGCD; and approved a permit for the DSWSC to pump water from its existing wells. This meeting also restored respect and understanding between the two entities, provided funding for public awareness programs, and secured a pathway to increase the DSWSC's ability to obtain an increased permit based on future needs.
- Stood firm against the efforts of the West Travis County Public Utility Agency's ("WTCPUA") attempts to modify the existing agreement between DSWSC and the LCRA. Mr. Cobb made the DSWSC's position known to legislators and local elected officials. He championed the position that the DSWSC Board of Directors had a fiduciary duty to its members and all other interest were a distant second to that.

In other business, the Board members elected director Shawn Connolly to serve the remainder of Mr. Cobb's term as president.
